Maybe He's Not Gay: Another View on Homosexuality

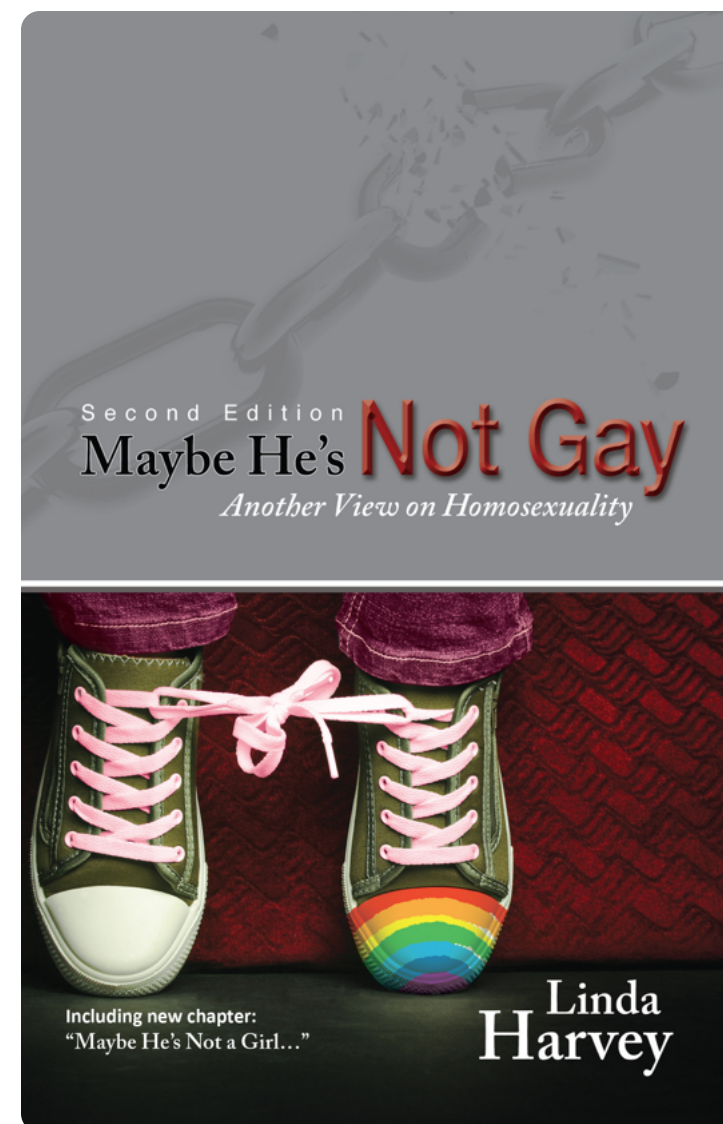
Have you read Linda Harvey's book? It makes a great read for your teens during the summer months.
